POSTAL ORDERS

PACKAGING AND DISPATCH

Rose plants are wrapped in damp paper and the roots are sealed to maintain moisture. They are then packaged in cardboard cartons and are sent via Australia Post. Roses transport extremely well. When your roses arrive, undo and place them in a bucket of water for a few hours to rehydrate the roots and reduce the stress on the plant before planting. Do not allow plants to dry out. To reduce stress on new plants, make sure to give them a thorough watering when you have planted them.

New Release for 2017

SMILING EYES



Soft peachy pink blooms that are single in form and warm to the centres with a rich rose and ruby red eye zone and bright golden stamens that are long lasting and produced in lovely clusters on this bush rose. Suitable for pots, borders or a single planting in the garden. The mass display of blooms on this new addition to the Eye Opener Rose Collection, introduced by Chris Warner, is held above dark green foliage that is strong and disease resistant on a neat compact plant to 80cm.

EYE SHADOW



A charming rose with waves of single blooms produced in clusters on this neat and compact plant. This new addition to the Chris Warner Eye Opener collection of roses has warm blushed blooms in multiple shades of rose, magenta and apricot, with a darkened blush eye zone of magenta pink followed with golden stamens on a healthy disease resistant bush to 1m. Continuous blooms all season.

Berry Delightful

Delightful pink semi double peony style blooms have a central eye marking of raspberry magenta, forms a low growing neat compact bush to 80cm.



Eye Of The Tiger

A healthy disease resistant low growing bush rose forms a neat compact plant to 90cm. Small yellow blooms have a central unusual red eye and is free flowering all season.



Eyes For You

A simple rose bloom that is soft white with a soft pink glow that has a central eye zone of dark plum and carries a great perfume. Incredible! 1.2m.



For Your Eyes Only

Forms a compact plant to 1m high and bears masses of warm rich large single blooms in shades of pink, plum and amber around a central dark burgundy eye zone.

Bright As A Button

An "Eye Opener Series" roses bred by Chris Warner. This variety carries masses of warm rich large single blooms in shades of pink and plum around a central dark burgundy eye zone. A compact plant to 1m high and ideal for growing in large pots.

Soul Sisters

Milky chocolate buds open to warm latte coffee, Well shaped blooms that age with a hint of lavender at blooms end. A compact floribunda with clean green foliage on a bush to 1 meter high.



The Golden Child

A highly fragrant floribunda rose with warm bright yellow blooms produced in clusters. Blooms open with wavy petals with some blooms up to a 35 petal count. Healthy glossy green foliage with mahogany new growth to 1.2 meters.



Pope John Paul 11

The pure white blooms of this well shaped hybrid tea rose has a fresh citrus fragrance. Produced on a strong disease resistant bush. 10% of the sale proceeds goes to local charities.



Gallipoli Centenary Rose

La Vien en Rose



A very strong fragrance adorns this newest addition to the Delbard painters collection of roses with its soft pink and white stripe splashed blooms. This variety is sure to please where a softer look is desired, as compared to the other more bright and bold colours of other varieties in this collection. Well shaped blooms on a strong plant to 1m high and 50cm wide.

Boscobel



One of the newest David Austin roses direct from England. This charming old style rose has large cupped petals that enclose blooms of a warm dusky deep pink. As the bloom opens it reveals a multitude of petals that wave and swirl to the centre. Blooms are freely produced all season and have a strong perfume on this sturdy upright bush growing with dark green gloss foliage to 1.5m.

Better Homes & Gardens



Large, well shaped hybrid tea blooms form on this new rose in a soft delicate pink with a soft and delicate perfume to match. This rose has been released for the most popular television show. This medium growing bush rose has dark foliage and is strong growing with good disease resistance. Blooms are freely produced all season on a bush to 1.2m.

Bordeaux



This new release rose from Kordes in Germany has a bloom of great appeal. Large, old style quartered and shallow blooms of warm red and a light perfume on this healthy disease resistant small growing bush rose. Ideal for pots or borders. On a height to 80cm and 50cm wide, this rose is sure to please where a small plant is required for that full sun to part shaded spot.

Classic red, well shaped hybrid tea blooms form the attraction to this charming new rose. Long stems and long lasting blooms as a cut flower make this a rose for the picking garden, with a medium fragrance to match its charm. Foliage is tough and deep green, and has a strong disease resistance on an upright plant to 1.5m tall and 1m wide.

Elysium Fields



This new rose has it all: strength, vigor, charm, fragrance and the most beautiful dusky, salmon pink colour. The large blooms are wide and open to reveal a multitude of wavy petals in an old world style and charm. This variety also performs well in humid environments and is a great new floribunda shrub rose with a healthy bush to 1.5m high x 1m wide.

Highly perfumed blooms that smell of lemon and apple on this old style romantic rose. Blooms encompass the most beautiful shade of light pink and are cupped and quartered at the centres. Blooms all season over dark green disease resistant foliage on a strong bush plant to 70cm high x 50cm wide.

Blooms are well shaped and of classic hybrid tea form.

Summer Romance



Our cover rose for this season is this great new floribunda shrub variety with an old world style and charm from the Kordes Parfuma collection. This new variety has a great future ahead as it has strength and vigor, and bears masses of highly fragrant blooms that have a romantic old style about them. Fragrant notes of apple, spice, myrtle, floral classic rose and liquorice scents. Blooms are freely produced on a compact tidy plant to 1m.

Amnesty International Climbing



New for 2017 is this Delbard climbing rose suitable for small spaces and old style open cupped blooms of soft yellow ageing to cream over dark foliage and a strong citrus rose fragrance.

A DAUGHTERS GIFT



Clear velvet red blooms with a white reverse to the petals on this hybrid tea rose. Blooms are beautifully proportioned and are large with a sweet light delicate perfume that are freely produced all season November to May on a low growing bush to 1.5meters, This variety supports the "Charles Gardiner Hospital Leukemia Fund" for research into Leukemia.

BERRY DELIGHTFUL



A new addition to the Eye Opener series by Chris Warner is 'Berry Delightful' with its delightful pink semi double peony style blooms have a central eye marking of raspberry magenta and is free flowering all season, ideal for pots or border plantings and is a hybrid Hulthemia/Persica shrub rose. A healthy disease resistant low growing bush rose forms a neat compact plant to 80cm.

BRILLIANCE



Large highly perfumed blooms of this hybrid tea rose are purest white that shine in a continuous breathtaking display all season with a pleasurable intense scent on a robust bush to 1.5meters. This variety supports the Murdoch Children's Research Institute.

CLIMBING FLORENTIA



This delightful old style rose is a welcomed new variety with brilliant red double cupped and quartered blooms with old fashioned charm that are freely produced on a robust climbing plant with strong disease resistance on a plant to 3meters tall x 1meter wide. Ideal for arches and small tripods and best grown in a full sun position.

COCONUT ICE



This old style modern Kordes bred rose has compact neat growth with a continuous display of old style nostalgic blooms that are in clusters of three to five per stem, blooms are mid pink and have a quartered formation with a white reverse to the petals and a light fragrance that are carried over dark healthy disease resistant foliage.

DARK DESIRE



Dark Desire I'm sure will be well received by gardeners with a classic well shaped hybrid tea bloom of beautiful dark burgundy red colour and fragrant. A classic new bush rose with bright glossy green foliage on a healthy and vigorous small shrub to 1.2 metres.

EYE OF THE TIGER



Another great new Eye Opener Rose to the new series of releases by Chris Warner is 'Eye Of The Tiger' this healthy disease resistant low growing bush rose forms a neat compact plant to 90cm. Small yellow blooms have a central unusual red eye and is free flowering all season, ideal for pots or border plantings and is a hybrid Hulthemia/Persica shrub rose.

FEARLESS



Fearless hybrid tea blooms of 'Brilliant' are an intense orange and carry a light sweet fragrance. This variety has won multiple awards and provides multiple flushes of the bold bright blooms and a feature is it's thick leathery foliage that can withstand summer temperatures on a strong bush to 1.5meters. Responds well with deadheading and is quick to repeat blooms and is a Bronze Medal winner at the Australian Rose Trial Gardens.

KORDES JUBILEE



Commemorating the 125th Anniversary of the Kordes rose breeding is this charming rose of old world style with modern qualities. Double blooms 12cm wide are yellow and quartered and have a pink trim and are freely produced over dark green dense foliage on an upright bush to 1.2 metres tall and is noted for its healthy foliage and growth.

SHIRLEY'S ROSE



Large fragrant full blooms with up to 40 petals that are cupped and quartered and are a delightful soft peach and apricot that open with outer petals a soft bone colour. Forms a healthy bush to 1.2 metres and has good disease resistance. Silver Medal winner in the Queensland trial gardens and \$1 of every sale goes to research into Pancreatic Cancer.

TWILIGHT ZONE



Very large buds open to old fashioned style beautiful blooms that are a deep velvet purple with a smokey hue and a rich strong fragrance of spice clove and citrus tones that are freely produced over deep green foliage and the strong bush grown to 1.25 metres and if you love 'Ebb Tide' rose, this is better!

WITH ALL MY LOVE



A great new hybrid tea rose with strong growth and long lasting blooms that are large deep crimson red with many petals and born on long stems on a healthy bush to 1.5 metres tall. Blooms are ideal as a cut flower and open with a slightly ruffled edge to the petals.

BELLE PARFUME



A new addition to the Delbard French rose Parfume collection is the stunning 'Belle Parfume' with cluster flowered double blooms that start out a lovely pink and mauve and age to pure mauve with a seductive intense fragrance, forms a tidy small shrub rose to 1 metre and has disease resistant dark green glossy foliage

COEUR DE NEIGE



The Delbard French rose Parfume collection has this new introduction with this cut flower variety with cut blooms lasting up to 12 days, blooms are a striking white with a pale pink heart and have a quartered formation and carry a delicious rose fragrance that is very strong. Repeat blooms all season on a bush to 1.2 metres tall.

TRANQUILITY



A charming new release from David Austin with old world charm. The beautifully shaped blooms are in perfect rosette formation and open lightly tinged yellow and later become pure white and carry a sweet apple fragrance. This bush rose grows to 1.3 metres high x 1metre wide and is almost thornless with healthy and vigorous growth.

WALLERTON OLD HALL



One of the most fragrant David Austin releases is this great new addition with a strong myrrh fragrance with a hint of apricot. Plump large buds open to beautiful chalice shaped blooms of soft apricot which pale to cream and are freely produced on a strong bush to with few thorns to 1.6m high x 1.25m wide. Can be used as a climbing rose to 3 metres.

Abracadabra

A thornless bush rose with amazing colour combination of yellow and burgundy stripe. This is a popular variety with no two flowers the same and forms a small bush to 1m.



Aotearoa

Light salmon pink flowers of perfect exhibition form. A very healthy bush rose with disease resistant foliage. Also known as the Pride of New Zealand and is one of Sam McGreedy's finest roses with intense fragrance.



Ashram

One of our most popular roses in recent times is this Hybrid Tea with large blooms freely produced on an upright bush to 1.2 metres. The well-shaped blooms are the richest apricot-gold that age with a sepia pink wash. Disease resistant foliage.



Augusta Luise

Large fragrant blooms of old world nostalgia. Apricot cream blooms flushed pink at the edges over a dark glossy foliated bush to 1.2 m.



Barbara Streisand

Barbara Streisand can grace your garden with classic shaped hybrid tea blooms that are lilac pink with a beautiful perfume too. Grows to 1.5 metres high.



Bengali

Well formed large cup shaped blooms, warm apricot and a strong fragrance adorn this must have floriferous rose that is a winner of multiple International gold and silver awards. Growth is to 1m high and 60cm wide with disease resistant foliage.



Best Friend

A rose of great beauty with classic formed bloom a vibrant deep, hot plum pink produced freely on a strong growing upright bush to 1.5 metres tall. Blooms are highly fragrant and last well as a cut flower.



Blue For You

Clusters of semi double blooms, rich purple mauve fading to slate blue over a long flowering period. Blooms have a strong sweet fragrance like violets. Strong disease resistant growth to 90cm.



Brass Band

Clusters of fragrant apricot blooms with a yellow reverse that repeat freely throughout the season. Grows to 1.5 metres high. I just love this variety, it is one of my favourites.

Bright Spirit

Richly coloured salmon and gold blooms with a wonderful spiced scent. Blooms are produced in an abundant continuous display over a strong bush with deep glossy green foliage, growing to a height of 1.5 metres tall.



Cassanova

A lovely Hybrid Tea rose with intense amber orange blooms, that have a strong damask fragrance. Blooms are large and full of petals and produced freely over dark green foliage on a bush growing to 1.2metres high.



Child's Love

The large blooms with frilled edges are of rich salmon pink with an amazing rich Old Rose fragrance. Happy in a large pot or in the garden. This bush rose grows to 1.2m round and provides both fragrance and interest to the garden with these unique blooms.



Chippendale

From rose breeder Tantau in Germany comes this rose with old world style blooms are cupped and quartered in apricot - pink with a strong perfume on a small growing bush 80cm x 1m.



Close To You

A perfect new Hybrid Tea with flowers held high on long stems well above the dark foliage. Blooms, of elegant creamy yellow, with a perfect perfume to match



Dame Elizabeth Murdock

An amazing hybrid tea rose with medium-large well shaped blooms. A magnificent blend of golden yellow, flushed with cream and edged in shades of pink.




Daybreaker

Ebb Tide

Wow! Deep smoky purple and fragrant. This rose has it all. Dusky deep purple-black buds open to very double old-fashioned style blooms with an intense fragrance. The velvet plum blooms are washed with a smokey haze. Growth to 1m.



Ekstase

Blooms are well shaped and a very dark red with a soft plum overlay on the petals the well shaped blooms have a light fragrance and are produced on a dark green foliaged bush to 1 metre tall, great for picking.

Elle

Fragrant blooms of pink-peach and are of classic form with a light fragrance, blooms are produced on mid green foliage. Flowers continuously over the season.



Falling In Love

A great disease resistant Hybrid tea rose with warm pink over white blooms and a soft fragrance on a strong bush to 1.5metres. Bronze Medal winner in 2009 and it is bred from two great roses Marilyn Monroe and Moonstone.



Fire and Ice

2008. Crisp white petals, are highlighted by bright cherry red tips at the edge of each petal. Brilliant display of blooms, excellent disease resistant dark green foliage on a plant to 1.2m. Gold medal winning at the Australian Rose Trial Gardens.

2009. This rose honours those men and women who risk their lives daily to protect ours. A well-shaped hybrid tea in very rich red. Intense and exceptional old rose fragrance with blooms produced on an upright bush to 1.6m. Bronze medal winner.




Forget Me Not

Golden honey yellow blooms on this floribunda rose are flushed warm peach and red melon tones. Free flowering bush ideal for landscape use with a real tropical feel to the plant, growing to 80cm tall with large well shaped blooms.

The well-shaped blooms of this variety have a rich sweet fragrance on a super strong bush. Blooms are a soft mid pink, well shaped and produced freely on this plant growing to 1.2 metres high.



Heaven Scent


Intense damask fragrance on a well-shaped Hybrid Tea rose, a lovely orchid pink shade. Award winning! Compact growing rose with dark green foliage.

Hot Cocoa

Velvet smoked rusted chocolate blooms with pointed buds, that open to double blooms which are ruffled and fragrant. As the blooms age they develop a purple suffusion. These unusual coloured blooms are produced on glossy foliage. Bush to 1 metre.



In Appreciation

A free branching bush rose with fragrant decorative blooms of deep luminous pink. Great for the vase with good disease resistance. On a strong upright bush to 1.5 metres tall.



Lions Rose

A delightful creamy white with double blooms and a light scent which are born in profusion on a strong healthy disease resistant bush to 1.5 metres.



Maggie

Dark green glossy foliage, topped with old-world style double pure white blooms. Good perfume. This rose named after Maggie Tabberer, with part proceeds benefiting the Melanoma Foundation of whom she is a patron.



Magma

A large golden yellow bloom, that is flushed red. Great for picking and produced on a strong growing bush with few thorns to 1.2 metres high.



Marilyn Monroe

Beautifully formed blooms with thick petals that are great for picking. Blooms are a light to medium apricot with a mild fragrance and are produced on a medium height bush to 1.3 metres high.



Monica

A very colourful rose bloom of bright orange. Long slender buds produced on single stems. Plant habit is medium tall with dark glossy foliage.



Mothers Love

Masses of soft creamy pink blooms flowering continuously on long stems. Lush, healthy deep green foliage and intoxicating fragrance.

Recent Release Roses



Neptune

Large blooms with good growth. Flowers are high centred and richly perfumed. The colour is mauve-purple, edges are flushed in plum as they open. Stunning!



New Kleopatra

Well formed show bloom in amber red with a yellow reverse. A very showy rose with startling colours. Plant habit is of medium size and healthy.



Oranges and Lemons

A novelty rose in shades of orange striped yellow. Large fully double blooms on a strong, healthy bush with burgundy red foliage. 2.5 metres.



Origami

A strong and healthy disease resistant small growing bush with stunning blooms that are white edged red. The well shaped blooms have strongly folded petals resembling folded paper hence the name. A light fragrance on this Gold Medal winning rose.



Our Vanilla

The colour is a vanilla-champagne with the outer base petals sometimes having a green hue. Dense growth and very healthy. Long stemmed, Well formed blooms in abundance, an excellent cut flower variety.



Paul Bocuse

Dark green foliage and exquisite blooms that are double with lots of pointed petals. Rich apricot flowers are lightly flushed pink as they age. A light but refreshing perfume on a 80 cm high bush.



Perfumed Passion

Since its release overseas this rose has received numerous awards, all of which are well deserved. Blooms of this exciting new rose are well shaped with a high centre. An interesting blend of pink shades. A rich strong fragrance. 1.2m.



Rhapsody In Blue

A great floribunda rose with masses of deep purple blooms over dark foliage. This variety has been around for a few years and we have had many requests for stocking this plant, as many people that have seen it, loved it! 1m.



Remember Me

Extremely strong healthy dense foliage, of medium tall habit. Blooms are of a completely new colour break, with the blending of fawn, cream, yellow and salmon. Very unique!

A beautiful, strongly perfumed rose. Named in honour of Sir Donald Bradman. Perfect buds that open to a classic rich red rose bloom. Deep green foliage and disease resistant growth. Magnificent perfume!

Celebrating a great Australian country music legend. This great strong hardy growing rose with mid green gloss foliage with bunches of bright rich golden orange-apricot blooms on a bush to 1.2 metres.

Spring Park Nursery Rose Cultural Notes



SITUATION

All roses grow best in a sunny, well-drained position. Roses can also be grown very well when shaded for part of the day. Roses grown in a shaded area will have a restricted amount of blooms and if the plant remains shaded and wet for long periods they are more susceptible to fungal diseases. A sheltered position from strong wind is preferred. The plant should have plenty of good air movement to help prevent mildew. Roses should have at least 5 hours of sunshine a day to perform at their best.

SOIL

Roses prefer to be grown in a medium to heavy loam about 35 cm deep with a good clay Sub soil. Clay soils can be improved by adding lots of organic matter such as well rotted manure. Gypsum can also be added to break up the clay before planting. Plants will grow in any type of soil but the more sandy the soil, less water and nutrients will be retained and should be replaced regularly, organic type fertilizers work best in this sandy soil situation.

PLANTING BARE ROOTED ROSES

Dormant roses are available during June, July and August. After purchasing your roses you should aim to plant them as soon as possible. If you cannot plant them immediately take care not to let the roots dry out. This is very important as if they become dry, the plants vigor and growth may be set back or in the worst case die. Soaking in a bucket of water and a cap full of Seasol added for a few hours before planting is also a good idea, this just helps the plant get the best start.

Dig a hole large enough to accommodate the roots of the plant comfortably so the bud union (graft) is just above the ground level. Place a mound of soil in the middle of the hole and spread the roots out over the mound. Place a light coverage of soil over the roots and we recommend that for each rose one dessert spoon full of Osmocote (8 to 9 month slow release fertilizer) be added, also a good handful of Blood 'N'

Bone can be added to the remaining soil that is to be back filled into the hole. Tread the soil reasonably firmly, leaving a basin around the rose to help retain water and water in thoroughly, if you like you can add Seasol or use the bucket of soaking water.

Standard roses are planted in the same way but with a stake placed in the centre of the hole for support first. Weeping roses are grown with a pole and a rose ring for extra support.

Rock Dust is a natural fertilizer product that can be added to your soil while planting to help with soil improvement.

Do Not add other manure that is high in Nitrogen (N) such as Dynamic Lifter as this can burn the roots.

Planting your Bare Rooted Roses



Step 1: Soak your rose in Seasol.



Step 2: Select your planting site.



Step 3: Dig your hole with mound in the middle and rose graft above the soil surface.

Planting your Bare Rooted Roses



Step 4: Apply slow release fertilizer and rock dust to surrounding soil.



Step 5: Back fill soil.

Step 6: Water in well.

PLANTING YOUR POTTED ROSES

Potted roses can be purchased and planted at any time throughout the year. It is important when removing the plant from the pot not to disturb the roots, as this could cause a severe setback to the plant. Dig a hole, twice the size of the pot so that the bud union is 50mm above the soil surface, add some slow release fertilizer to the soil, place the rose in the hole and fill with soil, water in well and finish off with a layer of mulch.

FEEDING

Roses are voracious feeders and for the best growth it is recommended that they be fed every six to eight weeks during the growing season. Vary the types of fertilizers at each application such as Blood and Bone, Organic Rose Foods, Liquid Flower and Fruit, or a Complete Rose Food, etc. In the spring we recommend that a top dressing of a complete fertilizer be worked into the soil. A good fertilizing rule is to feed plants at the start of Spring Summer and Autumn.

For newly planted bare rooted roses it is recommended that you don't use pelletized animal manure for at least a few months as the fresh new roots can be burnt off and set the plant back.

Water all fertilizers in well so that your plant will get the benefit and be able to absorb the fertilizer.

BLACK SPOT AND POWDERY MILDEW

These Fungal problems mainly occur during spring and autumn or when the weather is humid. They do not hurt the plant but is unsightly and in late autumn help aid the rose plant to go into dormancy.

Black Spot is a scattering of dark blotches on the leaves. Eventually leaves turn yellow and drop off. Powdery Mildew is a creamy white mould, which attacks the flower stems or leaves and buds of flowers. On the leaves white blotchy spots appear. The occurrence of both diseases is weather related. Black Spot thrives in humid, warm conditions.

Mildew usually occurs in the spring and autumn on mild days and cool moist nights. For the control of these diseases, spray with Triforine or any good black spot spray. During spring use these preventative sprays every 7 to 14 days. Lime Sulphur can be sprayed during winter dormancy as indicated on the bottle. This will help with fungal problems and will give your plants a fresh clean start in spring.

PLANTING YOUR POTTED ROSES



Step 1: Select your site for your potted rose to be planted.

Step 2: Dig hole twice as large as the pot.



Step 3: Apply Fertilizer to soil.

Step 4: Place rose in the hole, backfill and water in well.



Step 5: Mulch your newly planted rose.
